## **Apache Mission Celebration**

At a special worship service at San Carlos High School, WELS President Rev. Mark Schroeder gave the service's closing lesson. He said, "Humanly speaking, the initial efforts to reach the Apache nation with the gospel seemed to be an impossible task. Now, 125 years later, the Apache people are still hearing the good news, are still having their faith nourished, and are still thankful for those who brought the gospel to them."

WELS President Schroeder also noted, "The most encouraging thing about the work among the Apache people is that they are recognizing that the work of missions and ministry belongs to them. While we are still there to help and assist, it is gratifying that the Apache people are embracing the idea of training members of their tribe to serve as pastors and teachers, looking ahead to the day when all called workers on the reservation will be Apache."
